

1. This command advocates a clean and safe environment. Per reference (a), our policy is to:

- e. Prevent pollution by utilizing cost-effective environmental technology and procedures and minimizing the generation of waste and release of pollutants.

Continually improve our Environmental Management System (EMS) to ensure ongoing and measurable improvement, leadership, and stewardship in protecting the environment, pollution prevention, promoting safe work conditions, pursuing sustainable business practices and attaining our established environmental objectives and targets.
